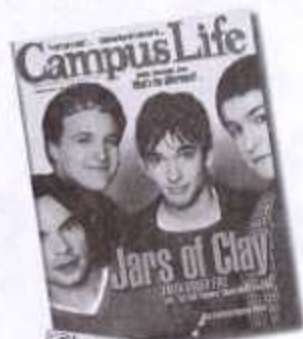




My kids were raised on campus life...
